

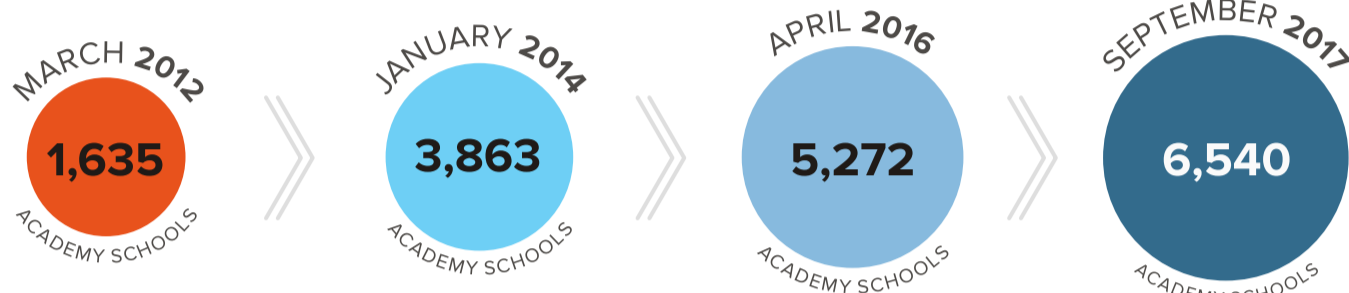
A guide to Academy Schools



WHAT IS AN ACADEMY SCHOOL?

Directly funded by the Department for Education	Independent of local authority control	In England only
Mostly secondary schools	Free to make own decisions on key functional areas such as staff pay and term dates	
Subject to Ofsted inspections	Can adapt the National Curriculum to their requirements	Subject to national tests such as SAT's and GCSE's
		Run by charitable trusts

TYPES OF ACADEMY SCHOOL

Converter academy

Successful schools that have chosen to convert to academies to benefit from the increased autonomy that academy status brings.

Sponsored academy

A former state school that has been transformed to academy status as part of a government intervention strategy. These are run by a Government approved sponsor.
