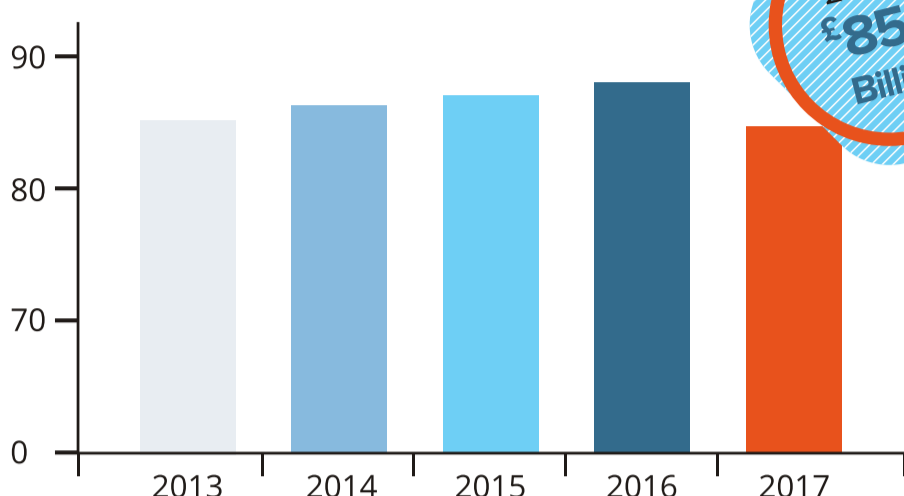


A guide to School Spending



Education budget



Individual school budgets

The overall education budget is split across all UK schools.

The new **National Funding Formula** aims for all children to get access to the education they deserve by ensuring that areas and schools with the highest need attract the most funding.

The National Funding Formula determines each school's budget based on a number of factors, such as:

- Number of pupils
- Levels of deprivation
- Special needs requirements

716 pupils

School Staff (including teachers and other staff): **£18.8 billion**



Catering Supplies: **£927 million**



Buildings and Maintenance: **£1.7 billion**



Administrative Supplies: **£312 million**



Learning Resources: **£1.5 billion**



Special Facilities: **£137 million**
